Greetings from the Good Shepherd Children's Home in Murfreesboro, Tennessee! We trust you are having a great Missions Conference and want to say thank you for your prayers and support.

For those not familiar with the Home, the GSCH began in 1962 with the sole purpose of caring for the needs of disadvantaged boys and girls. Most are from difficult backgrounds and have no family willing or able to care for them. Over the years, God has allowed the Home to have a part in the lives of over 1,500 children. While at the Home, our mission is to care for their physical needs, but more importantly, their spiritual and emotional needs. Many of the children we care for have never heard that God loves them and has a wonderful plan for their lives...they have only known heartache with little hope.

We currently have 18 wonderful children living at the Home ranging in age from 5 to 18, plus 2 staff children, for a total of 20...never a dull (or quiet) moment! We operate the Home "family style" and try to make the children feel like they are part of a normal home environment. They are currently attending Victory Christian Academy and are very involved in sports and other activities. God has given us a sweet spirit in the Home right now, which is a testament to the leadership of Robert and LeeAnn Brown, and over the past few months we have seen two more children trust Christ as their Savior.

Please continue to pray for Robert and LeeAnn and the rest of the staff as they deal with the children each day. Pray that God would give them grace, patience, and special insight in dealing with the children. Also pray that God would put a hedge of protection around the Home. We know that Satan would love to destroy a ministry like the GSCH, and we need God's wisdom, guidance, and protection as we try to fulfill the mission He has given us.
